Absolute Faith and Confidence

Some who believe never come to put their trust in Him, from their heart. When Abraham put his trust in Him, the YHWH made a covenant with him and Abraham proved it by circumcision. Abraham got the land our Father promised. There is absolutely no way that Abraham is not going to get that land. It will be through a people who have the same identical faith Abraham did, walking with Him in total obedience to Him, doing the deeds of Abraham.

Mark 16:16 — The last thing He told them to do. That is the absolute Word of God. Whoever calls on Him will not ever be ashamed, they will not ever be disappointed. They might be disappointed in themselves a little bit, but they will never be disappointed by Him.

1 Cor 12:12,13 speaks about the Body, the very body of a human being. Verse 13 — By *one* Spirit, not by two spirits, but one Spirit who speaks the same all over the world. One Spirit meaning one Body, unit, unity, united. He said that if you believe through the apostles, you will be one and the world will know that the Father sent Me. You are going to have the same identical unity as I have with the Father and you will be perfected in that unity. We are all baptised into the same Body, whether Jew or Greek, Spanish, German, French, English, American, black, white, Shem, Ham or Yapheth, the actual descendants of Abraham or not, it does not matter. The Body, one Spirit — a Spirit of truth and unity. YAHSUA said whoever believes through you (apostles) will be one. If there is any difference in the gospel, if we preach a different gospel than what Paul preached, we are accursed according to the Word of God.

Gal 3:26 — Faith is the very thing Abraham had when he believed and trusted Him and then YHWH told him to get the animals and split them in two and He walked through them and that absolutely confirmed that trust. Jews are fighting for that land with the arm of the flesh and that is absolutely an abomination. The Body of Messiah is spiritually waging warfare in our fighting spiritually against evil in every aspect of our lives — against everything that is evil — and He is giving us His grace to obey that.

If someone says he believes and does not obey His commandments, he is a liar, 1 John 2:3-5. And, he who loves Me keeps my commandments and I will reveal Myself to him. Do you keep His commandments? Jn 14:21; Gal 3:26. I am under His skin, clothed with Him because we are His Body, clothed with Him, Gal 3:27.

We are Abraham's seed. Scripture does not say *seeds*, but many people, *one seed* (Gal 3:16). If we are YAHSHUA's Body, we are the seed of Abraham and we have just as much power to speak the Word as YAHSHUA did. We are His seed, Abraham's seed. You can see that we are heirs according to the promise, Gal 3:29.

So it is our absolute faith and confidence in YAHSHUA when we call upon Him, designating our death, and when we come out we will walk in newness of life. Every day of our life we reject that old life, we reject the flesh. We live a life of self denial to that. We live a new life. When we go into the water, it confirms that faith.

In Acts 22 Paul saw our Master and our Master spoke to him. Then Ananias came later and said, "What are you doing laying there on the bed? Get up and get your sins washed away. Rise up and be baptised." Paul did not say, "I'm already saved brother. I saw YAHSHUA." There was no doubt in Paul's mind that he had to do it.

What happened on the day of Pentecost? What must we do? Call on YAHSHUA's name in the water and being baptised to receive the Holy Spirit who will never leave you.

[Four people responded to the Holy Spirit's call. First Monsey, a Spanish woman, then Robert, an Englishman; then Ursala (Ushi), a German woman; and then Pete, a German man who is Monsey's boyfriend (they had been living in a teepee in the mountains for 8 years — have 2 boys and a baby on the way). All four were baptised with great rejoicing in Sus. There was much thanksgiving and Praise to our Master's name.]

Later, in the Breaking of Bread:

Yoneq — Now you are disciples. All men will know that *if* you love your brothers and sisters as He loved you. This is a new commandment. This is how *you* will know that you have passed out of death into life. You *have* because you called out on His name tonight and you

received His life, but *we* know we have passed out of death because we love our brothers and sisters.

1 John is written for gnostics — those who have it in their brain but not in their heart. We are to live our life by laying our life down for our brothers and sisters. There is no other way we can know. If you do not love your brothers and sisters, you have not passed out of death and into life.

Of the early church they said, "My, how they love each other." It was obvious, evident that they loved each other.

Then ha-Emeq told a story about Nashon, a first-born son of the tribe of Judah whose life was spared by the blood of the passover lamb. His name meant someone who can tell what is going to happen in the future from noticing the things that are happening around. He had sensed that something was going to change there in Egypt for the slaves. His father told him to get one of the sheep and they killed it. "Make sure they see it Abba. If that lamb died for me, I want to make sure the death angel sees the blood there.

When the 12 tribes of Israelites left Egypt and the cloud led them to the bank of the great sea, and Moses commanded them to go forward, Nashon said, "If Moshe said go forward, I'm going forward." And he went. And then all the others followed and the water opened up into 12 tunnels of dry ground and all the 12 tribes passed through. Nashon was the first of the tribe of Judah — the leader. That day, Nashon was baptised. He jumped right into that water and was baptised into Moses (1 Cor 10:1). All those people when they went into that water were baptised into Moses.

Yoneq — The blood covers the house. If you are in the house, you are saved. The blood could not just stay in that bowl. The blood had to be applied properly — according to the word of Moses. It had to be applied properly, according to the Word of God.

Later, Philipe, our Spanish brother, received the name Nashon.
