Equality- Cham

"All men are created equal ..."

In the beginning this was so. But now man is fallen from his origin. There must be an accountability to the falls -- Adam, Ham, Israel. These falls destroyed the original equality of men. All men are under the curse of the fall of Adam. Ham fell under an additional curse - servitude (inequality). These curses can only be relieved in Messiah. Any attempt to undo these is to militate against God.

Martin Luther King, Jr. came in the name of the Lord as though Christ was sending him to set Ham free from the curse of inequality. But there is no equality of Ham in the world no matter how much is done by men. No amount of demonstrating, protestation, legislation will alter the reality of the inequality. Martin Luther-King, Jr.'s message promised freedom and equality which could only be attained in the body of Messiah. Did Martin Luther King, Jr. bring anyone into the body of Messiah? No. Then he is an Antichrist and a false prophet. (Jeremiah 23; Matthew 24:5) Something must come to undo the evil work that he did. He assumed that something that was set up by God was being undone. But this can only happen in the body of Messiah individually and not racially. The curse on Ham is lifted individual by individual.

Ephesians 2:12 defines the Church -- the community of Israel. What Noah said is bound in heaven. No man but Yahshua can remove this curse. A sent one must proclaim the good news of liberty. Ham and his seed were never meant to have equality. They had no right to it after the curse. No equal opportunity. This curse can only be broken through repentance. The curse upon Ham was intended to point him toward salvation. This must be put into us so we can proclaim the good news to Ham. They are under a double curse.

Thomas Jefferson, the author of the Declaration of Independence ("all men are created equal"), didn't free his slaves. Yet he saw slaves as human beings and he treated them with the respect that was due a human being.

A sent one proclaims freedom and liberty in Yahshua's name. John Brown was not sent by God to gain something for Ham apart from the Messiah. He was a false prophet. (Galatians 1:8) Martin Luther King, Jr. could not offer freedom if he was a slave himself (II Peter 2:13) to corruption or to the curse of Ham. A sent one is necessary!

Martin Luther King, Jr. said that, "We will overcome someday!" This was to come about when a sent one was sent to them. This was a prophesy like Caiaphas' prophesy about one suffering for the whole nation. Only through a preacher of righteousness can Ham be liberated! There will be those who will receive these things without any hindrance. In the next age everything will start anew. People in the next age will learn the shortcomings and failings of those in this age through us who till teach it to them.

Each man will be judged according to his potential to do good -- White Throne. (Revelation 21:8; 22:14) The second death is for those who didn't live up to their potential in this age. (Revelation 20:12; II Corinthians 5:18) Each person will be judged according to their potential in the body of Messiah what we do or don't do). Just as the world will be judged by the revelation of our Father's will -- whether we did it or not.

Revelation measures the worth of the man. What is revealed to you when you read the word? Judged against Romans 1:1-2. This determines how much the love of God is in you.

Equality outside of the body of Messiah is based upon the declaration of God about the fate of man and takes into account the falls of man. Man was made in the image of God. You sin against God when you sin against any man. Every man is equal under the law treated equally for equal offense.

All men are created equal, but philosophy refuses to acknowledge the fall(s) of man. In his humanity, man's heart, soul, and body has been greatly altered. The United States today is as it was in the time of Noah. Thomas Jefferson drafted up what could in no way come about except through the body of Messiah. Human nature doesn't allow equality. Differing amounts of motivation, incentive. Physical & natural abilities, and opportunities remove equality from men.

Egalitarian - philosophy which proposes to abolish the unfairness of human nature. This philosophy will only succeed in abolishing human nature itself. It will result in an equality of fact in defiance of the facts. It refuses to acknowledge the obvious inequalities in human nature. They propose equal rewards for unequal performance. They are against the divine ordinance.

B.F. Skinner was an egalitarian. The logic of the egalitarian Philosophy can be seen in this example. One man has a broken leg so you break everyone else's leg to make everyone equal. This is the ultimate goal of public education. To reduce everyone to the least common denominator.

Equality is based upon ability, talents, compassion not on sex, color, or race.

Those who look to the state to grant them their rights only succeed in elevating the authority of the state and suppress the rights of the individual. The Constitution is only to be appealed to in cases concerning the actions of the state. It is not to appeal to the state to establish rights - for the individual.
