Karl Marx was a mid-1800's Jewish German. He explained the laws that governed history from the beginning to end and concluded that man existed in the state, a form of primitive communism.

Evolution is the theory that things go from lower to higher state, as the evolution of history.

What is a communist? One who believes in reality as defined by Marx. "Reality" as in dialectical materialism. There is no such thing as God. Only matter. There is no basis for this in scientific fact. Mao said there is nothing more than matter in motion. Then man is a machine. Moral thoughts are only electrical currents. Man is a product of his environment, a prisoner of history. There are no moral absolutes, you view human life as a car. There is no such thing as inalienable life.

Hegel propounded the philosophy of dialectical materialism, the philosophy of conflict. Two polarized forces that clash. Thesis and antithesis. Thesis — something put forth. Synthesis — the result of the conflict.

Primitive communism — no selfishness, no sin, innocent. Barbarians were against everything the ancients stood for. They destroyed Rome. Ancients = thesis. Barbarians = antithesis. Feudalism = synthesis. Resulted in Lords (haves) and serfs (have nots).

In capitalism you reap what you sow. It's yours. Marx said capitalism was evil. But it isn't. He just saw people who were wicked and didn't share it. It's not a matter of what you possess, it's what your heart is. All injustice from capitalism would polarize the bourgeois and proletariat and revolution would come.

Socialism is a philosophy of equal benefit, government controls everything, every aspect of human life.

In communism you don't need government anymore. There is no sin, no temptation of bourgeois sin. The perfect communist world, utopia. A communist believes in this vision with all his heart. Jubilee without God. They are totally well meaning in their own eyes. It has borne witness with

his spirit and he has said "yes" with absolute conviction. The way the inevitable conclusion is brought about is by conflict. They believe that truth is whatever leads to the perfect communist world. They'll lie if necessary, their conscience is totally seared. The only evil is whatever hinders the coming of the perfect communist world. The communist belief: you enslave, you utilize, you destroy.

You build up something just to destroy it. Like the family. Promise the people everything they want, win them, then you have them as your slaves. Utilize contradictions to confuse people. Their goal is life to them. They will take over the U.S. except for one thing: us praying. Our government was instituted just to protect the rights of the people. If they're not willing to do it, decay sets in and it is taken over. You don't have to be a communist to bring about their goals. They manipulate everyone. They are extremely intelligent.
