

Connected to the Power of His Glorious Might

It's wonderful that Shoshana didn't wait until she got here to give thanks. I met her on the way and she was full of thankfulness. I was telling her how she was getting married [*14th December 1996*] and she will have to get a replacement — about 20 people, 20 single sisters. You can't get married unless there is a replacement. She is a wonderful servant.

Col 1:11 is after verse 10, which is after verse 9. Paul was praying for something. He didn't see it come about because it wasn't the time for it, the appointed time.

Lk 1:77,78 — It wasn't the time for the “sunrise from high” to rise and bring about the end of the age. If it happened in Paul's days, they weren't ready.

Lk 1:78 talks about the dawning and also about the rising of the sun. The sun hasn't risen yet — just the dawn saved you and us. It's going to rise because there is the dawn. When the sun rises it will rise until the full day, until the woman is clothed with the sun.

We supplant the enemy. We cause the land to go back to Yahshua. It's a race. The sunrise is in the beginning of the race. The beginning of the race is the sunrise. It'll shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death. Thousands will be saved. Houses and farms will be added to us. Now our Father is doing a great work in us through the things we do all day long. Very few are being saved now. When the sun rises hundreds will be saved, maybe thousands. They have to wait until the sunrise. They have been damaged so much. If the sun rose now we wouldn't be ready.

Col 1:10 — If we wash dishes — or anything we do — with complaint, it's a bad work, not a good work bearing fruit for the kingdom.

Verse 11 — invigorated with strength, forbearance with joy — wow, something has to happen to us for this to come about so that we would not just be tolerating but forbearing.

You see what it's going to take to endure until the end and put our Master's enemies under our feet. How many enemies do you have? We are responsible for our enemies.

When I go to different places I don't look at the flesh. Otherwise, believe it or not, I'd be shy and intimidated like my natural tendency is. I go, put the flesh under my feet, and look at the Spirit. When I went to Spain the other day, all I looked at was Yahshua.

We have to endure every day. We have to have every kind of endurance. There are different kinds of endurance. We have to attain to all steadfastness (Col 1:11).

It doesn't do any good to be patient with joy and forbearing without joy. Well, there it is, we do it in the flesh. It is going to require something. It is amazing what is required of us. It's amazing what was required of our Master. He did it and commands us to do the same. Somehow, we have to attain to His glorious power. We have to get it. Obviously, some of us don't have it. That's what encouragement does. That's why we have to get it every day. Grace is glorious power. Did you get it [*see Morning Minchah, 27 November 1996, Sus, and Morning Minchah, 28 November 1996, Sus*]?

About Dancing

In Hebrew the word for *dancing* and *festival* is the same. Nobody will be able to go to a festival who doesn't dance.

We started to have very brief dance classes for old men/young men sometimes after the minchot — 10 minutes or so — to help the men to come more into dancing. Jer 10:13 has to be fulfilled. It's the old men, the young men, and the virgins that dance together. As it is, the virgins usually know the dances, and the mothers are probably not mentioned in this verse because they might be busy taking care of their children.
