Created to Rule

Heb 2:8-9 — The day will come when all things (the universe) will be subject to Him. We don't see this yet. Ps 8 — Yahshua was a man a little inferior to the angels for a time. Eph 2:5-7 — He took the form of a bond-servant for us.

We were created to eventually rule the universe (all the works of His hand). This is our destiny. This is why our children need to listen and not get distracted. This is why they were created.

Ps 8 — What is man? David acted as if the fall never existed, and saw man as the Father's highest creation, who would someday rule the universe. We can't have a worthless spirit, having communication with evil spirits. Redeemed man doesn't think that way.

Our Master tasted death, took the whole bite of it for every human being. But now we already see Him wearing a crown of honor and man also (those who endure). He tasted death for everyone.

Look ahead — grasp hold of what we have been made to grasp hold of. Phil 3:12 — This is the hope we're reaching towards. But if we can't rule over our children, we can't rule over the universe. How will we rule then if we can't rule now?

Our Master was a slain Lamb before the foundation of the universe in our Father's thoughts (His pre-determined plan). Before eternity sets in, He will find out: **1.** Those who live by their conscience (the nations), and **2.** Those who are redeemed and will rule over the nations (sharers of the divine nature), one spirit with God — this will constitute the holy city. Rev 21:24-26 — Those of the nations are those who are natural man without the Spirit. But we have received Messiah and His Spirit lives in our hearts.

Many are going to be in the Edah (a mixed multitude) who will claim to see, but don't see. They will eventually fall and leave — they were an obstacle that was removed and their destiny is the lake of fire. Satan plants tares in the Body, those who didn't call on Yahshua as Sovereign. 1 Cor 12:3. There will be sons of disobedience among us here, Eph 2:2, who live indulging in the flesh. Jn 9:41 — Their guilt remains if they claim to see, but they don't see — they are a detrimental

influence in the Body. Don't ever be this way! If you cause hardship in the Body because of your actions (a hindrance) then you will be a heavy weight. Mt 12:30 — We are either for or against our Master. We either gather or scatter. Let's understand who we are, why we are breathing.

Wheat and Tares

Over the last 20 years we've seen this happen a lot — The difference between a tare and wheat. Our Father opposes a tare, but gives grace to a wheat. One is proud and the other is humble, receiving what our father has for them submissively and with grace. Let's cry out for grace to be this way.
