

Determination

Yacob Israel spoke about a woman that he met who has such an amazing dream-house. She also has a gift to make jewelry.

Yoneq responded that it would be so much better if that woman would give up her dream house now, because she sees the worthiness and glory of YAHSHUA, rather than that one day her dream house would come tumbling down and then she would come. We couldn't receive her then, because of what our Master says in Luke 16. When I was Christian I never saw the worth of YAHSHUA. I knew about a man, Jesus, but He certainly wasn't worth me giving up everything for Him. It is really wonderful that this woman has an opportunity to see the worth of our Master YAHSHUA.

Determination

The Body is a functioning body, like a human body. The body is separated from that world. If you are not in a functioning body, if you live in division, you are not in salvation.

Why are almost 6 billion people living on the earth? God wants us to have a life. Why didn't Adam and Eve just die and not have children? He made the first covenant with them. Why does God want man to multiply? He wants man to fill the universe. He wants the new man, YAHSHUA and the 14th generation to defeat Satan.

If you work for your own food and clothing, you still live in the world and you are not a part of those who put Satan under His feet. You have to come out of the world and seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness. The only purpose of this life is for the determination of where one is going to spend eternity.

Determination is a judicial decision. It is made by a superior. He judges you. A judgment must be rendered concerning all men. A judgment is a determinative action rendered from a judicial condition which is uncontrollably fixed. Once it is made, you cannot change it. You beg, cry, mourn, moan just like Derush did for months, but the judgment concerning what

he did could not be undone. [He begged Yoneq. He wanted only to live in the basement, but it wasn't given to Yoneq to let him come back.] If people live according to the second covenant, they will have eternal life in the nations - the sheep nations. Matt. 25:34 - 46; Rev. 21.

God is going to make a determination on all men according to how they lived by the natural law that God put into all men. Of course as a disciple we come into a higher consciousness. We have a higher standard. We received a brand new slate, a conscience that detects everything.

Rev. 20:11 - 15 You see that judicial decision, that determination that is made for all men who were not in the Body of Messiah. It is based on Rom. 2:14,15 - the natural law that all men know about. It is even in encyclopedias.

God is the determinator. You have only one life to live. Once I had a dream about someone who was judged for eternity, and I got a sense of that terrible, horrible loneliness that goes on forever.

Those who live according to Gen. 3:15 - 22 will live in the nations.

If I were you [*to our guest*], I wouldn't take a chance. If you think you are good enough to go through that judgment, then you are proud enough to go to the second death.

Heb. 9:27 - The judgment determines whether you have a second life or a second death. Matt. 25:41,46 speaks of that determination based on what those men did in that certain case. If you want to see what you are saved from, read it sometimes.

Rev. 19:2,3 - The fate of Christianity, the harlot - you just need a little sense to understand that. Fools don't understand that.

Rev. 22:11

Rev. 14:9-11; Rev. 21:8

Rev. 21:24,26; Rev. 22:2 - The nations who survived the judgment. They don't partake of the essence of the tree, only of the leaves. The Holy City partakes of the essence. No one can enter the Holy City unless their name is in the Lamb's book of life. You have to pay with your

life. He paid with His life - you pay with your life. Everyone in the world is going to go to the first death unless they are in the Body. Then Matt. 25:34.

Rev. 21:24,26 - nations and Holy City - they are distinguished. This is talking about the eternal age. The second death - there is no extinguishing, no expiation.

How do you know you have passed out of death into life? You have a good feeling? No, it is because you love your brothers, you seek first the kingdom, you pour out your life, you don't work for yourself, your life is a drink offering. In the old covenant there was a burnt offering, meal offering - all your possessions are ground up and given, and then the drink offering - you pour out your life daily on the Body. Paul said his life was a drink offering - that is why a crown of righteousness is waiting for him. 2 Tim. 4:8. If we do all these things, and also go to the peace offering with a good conscience, then we are longing for His return. We won't shrink back.

Right now we give our bodies as a living sacrifice. Mal. 3:16-18. The day will come when it is going to be clear who serves Baal and who YHWH.

We need to let people know about the second covenant and their conscience so that they could see that they are guilty and have broken it and that they could see their need for our Master YAHSHUA.
