Distraction

Ask Him only for the desires of your heart. Without desiring people to be saved, *we* cannot be saved.

There will be no tribe that does not dance. Our Father saves dancers — people who love to dance. There is dancing in the psalms — an expression of love to our Father.

We live in a spiritual world. The evil one is at ear level. Your head is in the air. We cannot allow the evil one to minister to us; he gives us messages. When we are distracted, is it holy angels or ourselves? What distracts us? Is it a natural phenomenon? Or is it another spirit? There is the Holy Spirit, and there are unholy spirits. So when our children are distracted and you cannot get their attention, it has to be because another spirit is occupying their attention. When we are distracted, it has to be that another spirit is doing it to us. If we cannot read, our mind is distracted by other spirits. Is it your own brain? Your brain has to be given an impulse from somewhere. Your brain is directed by the life within you, by whatever spirit your life is connected to. Therefore we have to keep our mind on the Holy Spirit. Eph 6 talks about the battle we are in. A battle is raging. It is so subtle that you do not even know you are being taken away and distracted. The enemy is so subtle.
