Doing the Works Prepared for Us

(Letter from Kephir to Yoneq and ha-Emeq)

Greetings in our Master Yahshua ha Meshiach! First of all I really want to appreciate the time I had in Judah, especially while I was going to the Apostolic Workers' meetings and being stimulated by the Word.

One of the things which has continued to be revelation to me is that sheep long to know or have confidence in the fact that what they are doing (the works) is what our God intended for them to do before the foundations of the earth. I look back at my life and see that I lacked confidence in knowing that the works I did were what were prepared for me to do before the foundations of the earth (Eph 1:4,11; 2:10) because I was not abiding in His Word — abiding in the vine. Now, every day, the cry of my heart is that I would be doing what I was created to do. It has become revelation to me — apart from Him I can do nothing; because when I look back at the works of my own hands they amounted to nothing — the works of the flesh.

I know that if we have any secret or hidden things we hold dearly to in our lives (2 Cor 4:2-3) the gospel we preach will be veiled. There will be a contraceptive to receiving the life from the gospel. I know in my past I haven't had the confidence to bring the gospel because of the things I allowed myself to be degraded with. I am so thankful that when I submit to God I truly have the power to resist the devil and he does flee from me (James 4:7). I feel like for the first time in my life I am having real victory over the things that beset me because I am going to the throne of grace and receiving grace to help me in my time of need (Heb 4:16).

Some of the things we've been talking about in our sacrifices is, "Is Yahshua enough for us?" and, "Do we have other things we give ourselves to along with Him?" and, "Can we drink from two cups (1 Cor 10:21)?" and, "Does His love overwhelm us (2 Cor 5:14)?" and, "Are His desires becoming our desires (1 Tim 2:3,4)?" and, "What are His desires?" These questions have been a stimulant, causing people to examine themselves and provoking a response. We have been here three full weeks, and it has been good; the response we've been receiving from the word being taught.

I am thankful for how our Father has been speaking here. We know it's only because of your prayers and us continually crying out. This is the only way we will endure until the end.

We are thankful to our Master for the anointing that is upon you.
