I Chronicles 12:22 Before the restoration can come the Lord must gather together a great army. We must wait until that time as the Lord changes our heart. (Read I Chronicles 12-17 before Wed.). Restoration can only be achieved by the voice of the Lord - the pattern. Before the Lord will come suddenly to His temple, the sons of Levi must be refined in every aspect. I Chronicles 15:28; I Chronicles 13:7, 15; 15- 15:2 we are either carrying the ark on a new cart or on poles According to the ordinance. It will be according to the sensitivity of the circumcised heart - those who give themselves entirely to the Lord who harbor no bosom sins until the Lord does a thorough work in our soul and body. Amos 9:11, Acts 15:13-18.

Unless the tabernacle was built perfectly in the temple, God would not dwell there. If it was built by the flesh. If we try to bring it in by our own understanding - which we are never supposed to lean on - we are going to have to steady it by the arm of the flesh.

We can't even be kind to one another, our nervous system, we can't even be patient we get frustrated. Satan has wormed his way into every part of our life. Every aspect of us must be restored.

Jonah 862 B.C. - Northern Kingdom who fell 150 years later; Amos 787 B.C., Northern Kingdom Hosea 785 -725 B.C. - Northern Kingdom; Southern Kingdom: Obadiah 887 B.C. Joel 800 B.C. Isaiah 760-698 B.C. Micah 750-710 B.C.; Nahum 713 B.C.; Habbakuk 626 B.C.; Zephaniah 630 B.C.; Jeremiah 629-588 B.C. (Jeremiah 20 and 29) Ezekiel and Daniel - post exilic or during the exile, Daniel was taken to Babylon in 606 B.C.; Ezekiel was taken in 598 BC at the age of 25 he started prophesying 5 years later in Babylon; Ezekiel 595 -574 B.C. Daniel 607 - 534 B.C. ; Haggai, 520 B.C. Zechariah 520-518 B.C.; Malachi probably around the time of Nehemiah 432 B.C.

After captives were let go Esther came on the scene in Babylon 485 - 465. Zerubabel came out in 536 B.C. Ezra came out in 465 B.C. Ezra 5 talks about prophets Haggai and Zechariah - Ezra came up years later from Babylon to give the people the law - they had the temple but they didn't have the law. In Ezra 9 he comes back with great joy and his heart is crushed by the intermarriage of God's people. He sat down appalled in the middle of the street and the faithful ones gathered around him. So at the time of evening prayer Ezra rose with his garments torn and cried out to the Lord. Ezra 9:5, 10:1 Ezra restored temple worship but the walls were torn down and the gates were burned. Nehemiah came back in 445 B.C. Nehemiah was so grieved when he heard about the walls being torn

down that he was unhappy around the king for four months. But he had favor with the king.

If we have not received the revelation to make the Jews jealous in our own heart then we have not received Paul's ministry in our heart. We have not received Apostolic Ministry in our hearts. The demonstration of the kingdom through spiritual Israel must make natural Israel notice and be jealous in order to stir their hearts so that they can weep when they look upon Him whom they have pierced.

2 Timothy 3:14 is one of the most important emphasis in the entire scriptures. Also in Romans 15:4 the true church won't divide over the scriptures. How shall we escape if we neglect the great thing, the Lord did in giving us the scriptures those on whom (Revelation, salvation, etc.) the end of the ages has fallen. I Corinthians 9:23-10:11.
