

Enduring in Messiah

2 Cor 5:17 — We were joined to Messiah; we are a new creation. The letter was to the Corinthians; it was not written to people outside the edah, but only to people who were actively involved in the Body of Messiah in Corinth.

Titus 2:14 says redeemed from lawless acts outside in the world so they can be actively involved in building up the Body. The same translation says *sin*, iniquity.

We are reconciled now, friends with God. An enemy is someone who loves the world (Jms 4:4). They prefer the world over God. God is going to destroy His enemies someday.

Eph 2:12 — If we are in Messiah, we have been appointed for eternal life. One time we were outside of Messiah but now we are no longer outside of Him. You cannot have Messiah outside of the community. Someone may come in and not really have faith, but later on they will end up leaving. 1 Jn 2:19 — They were never really appointed.

We are now in Messiah and we are to endure until the very end by His grace. That is why the bride lays the crown at His feet — because she only did it by His grace. But she is worthy to wear the crown because she was willing to do His will so He could give her grace. You cannot even be illuminated apart from His grace.

Mt 6:31 — You cannot be in the world and be saved. We do not work for our own existence anymore, we work for the existence of the kingdom of God. We no longer work for our four and no more. (We are saved from that perverse generation.) That is the first salvation message that was preached after Messiah died and rose again. That is the pattern for all ages. If a church ever exists it would be like the first church in Jerusalem. That is the prototype. When people see us they see a people. They are supposed to see that. When they see the Basque (people) they see a people. But the people of God are made up of people from all of the nations of the world (Rev 5:9-10) — tribes, tongues, nations.

Are we going to endure after we have come into His people? By His grace we endure. You cannot endure in Messiah if you are outside of Him. You cannot have Him outside of the community.

It is just like circumcision. The Jews used to circumcise by faith. Then it became a ritual and it didn't make any difference if they did or didn't do it. Just like baptism — if it is not done by faith, it doesn't matter. That is why people leave — it wasn't done by faith.

Eph 2:10 — He didn't preordain any good work for you outside the Body. It has to be in the Body. Christianity has taught us (corrupted the whole world) that we could do these works outside.

Dt 26:16-19 — We are building up the Body from within to be a high mountain. It is going to be a great and mighty nation. It is going to startle the world because they will see the loyalty of Yahshua's followers to Yahshua. Kings will shut their mouths.

Acts 26:7 — Presently they were serving God in the commonwealth of Israel, the church of the living God. That is where you find life. That is where you will endure until the end.

A lot of people are afraid (people told that to Yoneq in America) because people have been here for ten years and then they left. Well, that's right. When the proper circumstance came, the right pressure, they left. It is not hard to endure when everything is going fine. They were never appointed. If you are appointed, you cannot be disappointed (Rom 10:11,13).

Mt 21:43 — If you want to be saved, come into the place where you can produce the fruit of the kingdom of God.

Gal 3:16,29 — The seed is Messiah and Messiah is Abraham's offspring.

Acts 3:25-26 is a message to the natural Jews to repent. Every way outside of Messiah is a wicked way. To repent means to come in to Messiah. The blessing is only in Messiah.
