Fellowship

*Fellowship* — Social, mental, spiritual, emotional, physical, intercourse. Living together in community requires all one has (Luke 14:33), possessions; forsake all he has (Phil 3:7-8, #657), possessions belonging to him, his own, what he owns, all of his own possessions (5225 NASB), property.

There can be no *koinonia* between participants in the New Covenant Community priesthood without obeying Luke 14:33 first, as Acts 2:42,44,45 make clear. Then after this is settled, the fellowship is not hindered, but all depend on all the others to work together in communion, devoted to the *koinonia* in all aspects of what *koinonia* means in the Body life. There is no fellowship with Messiah unless one obeys His gospel — Luke 14:33, or 12:31-33; Mark 10:29, or 10:17-30.

1 John 1:3,6,7 — Fellowship with God requires absolute surrender, as Luke 14:32, as the word *possession*, giving up to the king. Fellowship is secured by surrender of all things belonging to you (Luke 14:33). Fellowship means in these passages of Scripture *Koinonia*, and *koinonia* means in Greek *Partnership*, (literally) participation of all aspects of self, distribution of one's goods and gifts, *contribution* — contributing members of the Body (Eph 4:16), communicative ones.
