## The Gospel Yeshua Preached

How could we be if we have never responded to the gospel? 2 Corinthians 11:4; Galatians 1:6 Are not we saved and born again, baptized by the Spirit by our response to this good news? Have we received eternal Life in the same way as those who had to give up all in order to follow the Savior? Mark 10:31 Can one have eternal Life when they have not even obeyed the first requirement of the gospel Jesus preached? What makes one a part of His Body? Is it not obedience to the gospel? John 3:36

Today 'Righteous Lots' must be more righteous than Lot was in Abraham's day - if one is to be saved he is saved in Abraham's seed - Messiah.
