**Desire** — request, longing, craving, wish, prayer, object required, reaching out with deep and persistent demand for. We should have a deep desire to follow our Master with all our heart.

### **A Heart of Compassion**

Col 3:12 — "Put on a heart of compassion ... " Paul wrote a letter to the Colossians because he heard they weren't being compassionate. Obviously there was something going on that they weren't forgiving one another.

Mt 21:43 — The kingdom was taken away from Israel and given to a nation of people producing the fruit of love. That's who we are beginning to be. We weren't looking for it, but He found us. We were chosen.

**Hospitality** — receiving strangers and guests without expecting a reward. **Kindness** — temperament and disposition.

How do we get *agape* love in there? We are supposed to be a light to the nations, even in hospitality. We are a foolish nation without understanding, but we are coming to understand who we are.
