Helping Our Children to Have a Good Conscience

Heb 10:22 — We come forward and draw near, as near as we can to our Master.

If you can't draw near, you don't have a good conscience. It's wonderful how we know that He has put it into man.

When the children are ten years old they are pretty responsible. When they get 11, 12, 13, they are almost totally responsible. They can lift hands with us because they have a good conscience.

They would confess anything to their parents. Nothing is hidden. Is there anything in your conscience, like arguments with your brothers and sisters, having been selfish, not having obeyed your abba and imma? If you have a good conscience you can look right into the eyes. Someday we will look Yahshua right in the eye. There will be no accusation. We will be one with Him.

There will be no division between children and parents, brothers and sisters.

I'm thankful we have such wonderful children. When they get to be eighteen they will go through a great transition. They will be the most perceptive, knowing all the strategies of the devil. They will turn many to righteousness, make them spiritual and shine like the stars. We don't need carnal friends. We make our carnal friends spiritual. Then you have friends. They follow you all over the universe. Sometimes you just have to expose something that is not right in somebody, but then they will be so thankful.

Social Meeting

Make sure you confirm your children, strengthen them. If not, you will lose them. They want a good conscience. They want to please you. You recognize their good conscience. There is a reward there.

Do you all talk to your children before the minchah about their daily activities, about how they are doing, whether they have a good conscience? Make sure they can look you in the eye, and you can look into their eye.
