Heresies

All divisionary people must be extracted from the Body. Stubborn refusal to listen to correction reveals inner perversion. It is characteristic of a divisive person. One who promotes division is no peacemaker, and therefore is no son of God (Mt 5:9).

Today Christian cult ministries name as heretics or cults or sects those whom they classify as *on the fringe*. They say such people promote dissension by propagating extreme views of legitimate Christian truths. They allow no one to rock the boat. All must remain middle of the road, regardless of where that road is headed (Mt 7:13).

The meaning of the word heresy is *choice* or *party*. Heresy refers to self will or sectarian spirit; parties are called heresies. This is the work of the flesh (Gal 5:20-21; Titus 3:10-11). All so-called denominations were started by a heretic with a sectarian spirit. God's approval is upon those who are under the anointing (1 Cor 11:19). No one who is of a sectarian spirit, who belongs to a division in the Church is able, fit, or worthy to enter the Kingdom of God (Gal 5:21). They side with a divisive person who started the division or denomination and gave it its name.

But a faction is *good*, for it separates and distinguishes those who are not under God's anointing and approval from those who are. James 1:12 — One who perseveres under trial is blessed, but refractory people always divide when the heat is turned up.

Ps 139:24 — When we are tried it exposes *any hurtful way* so that we would be worthy of the Kingdom. This includes all inadvertent and *offensive* ways, however we are abusive, annoying, detestable, discourteous, displeasing, disrespectful, embarrassing, impertinent, insolent, irritating, objectionable, rude, uncivil, unmannerly, aggressive, attacking, invading, pushy, *or taking offense at any wrong doing*.

Ps 139:24 — The Way Everlasting is the way of the Kingdom — perfectly prepared for Yahshua. Dan 12:2, 10; Jer 25:5. Forever and ever. Israel is everlasting, forever and ever. Jer 7:7; Gen 17:8; Is 49:16-17. A divisive person is cast out as one not under the anointing. 1 Jn 2:27-28; 1 Jn 2:19.
