Becoming Like Children

In Zechariah it says that our Master Yahshua's feet will actually stand on the Mount of Olives, the feet that were crucified, that have holes in them. He will stand there with all of His holy ones, the overcomers, looking to the east of Jerusalem, and a spring will go to the Mediterranean. He will stand on the same place where I stood a little while ago. All the holy ones, those who loved Him, who overcame every day will be with Him.

You could be someone in the world, get a better job, be a secretary. I see the girls washing lettuce. They could be doing greater things that look better, but they wouldn't be there on that day with our Master. That counts. They are laying down their lives for our Master. We are going to be there with our Master who will be standing right there in this place with His feet, and our feet will be there, too.

His name is One. Did you know that? I don't know how many will overcome from the twelve tribes. I don't know how big exactly Mount of Olives is. Yahshua shall be one and His name One. That is very significant. He is only going to be with those who are one with Him. Any outward separation negates oneness. We have to be one in spirit and one in everything.

We are to be one as He is one with His Father. I want to be one. That's why we go to the throne right now and gather so we can be one. One is one — it cannot be two. If we are not one, we cannot be there with Him on that day. Those who are with Him are gathering. I saw the girls today, washing lettuce. They were gathering. You all must have worked I don't know how long on that lettuce, and it was consumed in five minutes in everyone's body.

People are washing dishes every day. Nothing better to do than to serve our Master in this way. The first will be last, and the last will be first. Isn't that wonderful? Those who want to be first will be last. I tell you — better be kind to those who are last now. Our Father is going to balance it all out. There is going to be a wonderful judgment of the motives of everyone's heart. We will see who was obeying His word.

Don't envy that person who is doing something better than you. You better be content washing lettuce. That's how you serve your Master. The day is going to come: "Well done, My servant — you were faithful in small things; I'll give you greater things; you will get greater things." As we grow in the Body, of course we'll get greater responsibilities. We want the first and the last to rule with our Master. Not all the first will be last; not all the last will be first.

We are here to worship and serve our Master. What is *one* in Hebrew? We have to find out. Let all those who are one lift up their hands.

Becoming Like Children

Our Master said He wanted us to be like children. If we are not like children we are proud. We have to become like them. The adults have to become like little children. If you say to a child, "Say *shalom*," he says it with all his heart. When we said this morning, "Let's all say *shalom*," someone said, "Ah, I'm not going to say it." That person is proud. He won't enter the kingdom. Isn't that wonderful that he won't enter? It's wonderful, because our Master said it. We say *shalom* as loud as we can, and pretty soon our voice will be developed.
