## Hue and Saturation

Prophets who don't know the Word can lead us into error if what they say is not based on the word. We can't project the truth without knowing the truth. We can't make right decisions without being based on the word. By His word we will be saved. If we continue in His Word we'll know the truth. We'll be set free from bondage. In order to be led by the spirit we have to be led to behave in certain ways. If we're led by the Spirit we're not under the law, but if we're under the law when we die a physical death we will go to hell. We must subject ourselves to God. This is of our free will. We desire to do it. Yahshua had his life to keep or give up. This is the law of liberty we're under. We do this because we love Him. We desire to obey his commandments. This is how our Master walked. He had authority over His own life. He chose to give it. This morning I can give my life or keep it. I have the Holy Spirit who is my friend, the companion of my spirit. He does not have to force me to do anything. A husband doesn't have to force himself on his wife. It's wonderful that we can wake up every morning and give ourselves to Him.

We can project our self life on others, on ourselves and this brings death. But life comes out of the projection of the spirit. Our Master projected himself, his spirit, on his people. You project yourself on your children and they respect you. You communicate vividly in telling them what your will is. The same with your wife. It is not grey. It comes into a full developed color. When someone vividly projects their will to you it is a test of love to see if you obey. A husband must have plenty of hue and saturation to project a vivid color to his wife so she doesn't guess what he meant. So we must have that ability to project our spirit. If we do this it will engender respect. You don't notice someone you don't respect. For instance when your husband comes into the room. Husbands love your wives. Wives respect your husbands. James 3:11. If the spirit is our source it will bring sweet water. Wives and children will receive that good water and bear good fruit. If I'm not led by the spirit today then I'm under the law. If I'm under the law I must die. The works of the flesh are obvious. So are the works of the spirit. Both are vividly communicated. So we know how to make judgments. If elders know the word they can judge

objectively. Otherwise its left to an inspired speaker led by his emotions. How can I be led by the Spirit? I have to give my sovereignty over. Make a decision to give my body, mind, emotions and will under the supreme authority of Yahshua. This is what you do in the mornings. If you do this you can say "Yahshua is my Sovereign." Then you know you will not die. I can think as I want, act as I want, but must willingly give over my sovereignty. Luke 9:23; Mark 8:34; Matthew 16:24; Romans 8:14; James 4:7-8.

Matthew 13:11 -- unless people gain understanding by the teachers teaching what the prophets say the evil one comes and snatches the word away. Verse 29 -- be careful because now the wheat and tares look alike (while still growing). So we must treat everyone as wheat right now. Now we have a lot of things in us while we're growing but at the harvest we'll be golden. Tares show their true colors as they ripen (black).

We should never be lacking life and peace if we're being obedient. Depression is the work of the flesh to rob us of the seed the spirit is planting in us.
