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Making Jews Jealous

We need to know the difference between psalms, hymns and spiritual songs especially before the festivals. Some songs are for exhortation, some are songs He sings to us, and some are songs we sing to Him. Should we sing to Him looking up into the air? Is He in the air or is He in our brothers? We can't have a festival until we have all our own music, dances and instruments. We have to be graduated out of "Jewish" dances; we don't know where they are from. We need choreography, writers, etc. We need to make our own instruments. Fifteen years ago we were told to have sanctified music and sanctified instruments — David's Harp. David didn't go to Philistia to purchase his instruments. Music from David's heart and harp was pure, sanctified, set apart. It drove away evil spirits.

Our festivals will make the Jews jealous. We are already in New York and are about to go to southern Connecticut so we can make the Jews jealous. This is where there is a great concentration of Jews living. The Jews will envy our lives. Rom 9:3. Paul loved His people so much he would have given up his eternal life if they would be saved. He had a burden for the Jews, his fellow brothers. Rom 9:3 is what you call a burden, it is up for us to carry on where Paul left off. We take on his burden. The gospel is to the Jews first, then to the nations. There are some Jews who haven't lost their identity as Jews, not losing their connection with their culture. Judah is extended over into New York to love the seed of Abraham. Paul said the Jews are unloving, but so are we. We may be Jews and not know it. We are adopted in and there is no partiality but there is still a promise about the Jews. We pray for the Jews who really want to be saved.

Zeph 2:7. The house of Judah is on the sea coast. We will walk in Connecticut along the seacoast, two from every household. It is the Ashkelon walk. Ashkelon is where you are weighed to see how much glory you have, how heavy you are. Our first house in Connecticut will be called Ashkelon. The heavier we are, the more communion we have, the more unity we have with our brothers and sisters. John 17:22 "That they may be one just as We are one." If we are

Ichabod, no glory, then it is impossible to submit to one another. We don't mind submitting to our wonderful King, wonderful Master. He has glory and has given His glory to us so it's not hard to submit to one another or submit to your husband. We have a kind Master in Yahshua.

Let's submit to Him right now, giving Him the glory, honor and praise. Ephesians 5:21

Yoneq — Whoever are led by the Spirit are the sons of God. In the Jesus movement they were receiving a spirit but the Spirit I received didn't mesh with their spirit. It is very difficult for a man and a woman to give up their house unless they've met Yahshua, the Master.

ha-emeq — Rom 9:1-4. It is wonderful we have this same heart. Paul, in verse four, would give up his eternal life because they are Israelites. We know about the curse on the Jews. I love and respect the Jews. It is wonderful to have this love and respect in us. We talk about how they are hostile to others, and this explains their life. So we know this, and at the same time we want them to be saved. Abraham and Yahshua were Jews. Yahshua was the best, He wasn't hostile to men.

Yoneq — Irregular communities don't teach Hebrew. Regular communities teach Hebrew. We will speak Hebrew in the next age.
