Just Touching Base or Having Communion?

1 Cor 12:13 — I read something today that was so wonderful. It says, "We were all..." — It's a past experience. It's over with. We are in the Body. This talks even about carnal believers. Most of the Corinthians were carnal. He is telling them, "Hey, you are in the Body. You have an Advocate." God is love. Agape love is patient even if a person taxes your patience. How much do we tax our Father's love? He is Agape. He is kind.

Sometimes we just touch base with each other (that's an American expression), and do not really have communion. So our Father wants us to touch base with Him every day? What does our Father want from us? *Communion*. We don't want to be carnal.

We were all baptized; it's a past experience. Nothing is going to take that from us. We are to make the best of it by His grace. We have hope because He loves us.

[Looking at the half moon...] One day we will be like the full moon. In Isa 60:20 it says that the moon will not wane. We will be a full reflection of the sun, fully reflect the light. We will be clothed with the brilliance of the sun.
