Liar

Rev 14:10 — The second death. After the first death all are resurrected to see if they will go to the second death. The smoke of their torment is forever and ever. (That means it has no end — if it is just "forever", then it is only until the end of the age.)

Rev 21:8 — all liars .

Rev 19:3 — her smoke rises forever and ever.

Is 34:10

What is a liar? A liar is a person who comes here and says, "I want to be saved" but they don't.

LIAR — one who knowingly passes untruth by word or deed — all those go to the second death.

That is the truth. I asked Havaret if she is a liar, is she passing untruth? Was she convicted by the Holy Spirit? Or did she want to join the club? Did she love YAHSHUA with all her heart? Is she like a person who we can believe, who we can trust? No one who received the Holy Spirit can think about leaving Israel. You read Esther — about that rebellious woman. You should have more wisdom than the universe could contain. The Old Testament is so wonderful. Don't ever say they don't let us read the Old Testament there. It is full of wonderful wisdom.
