

Looking for a Home

This has been our Father's ultimate purpose (His intentions) from eternity past, however long it is that creation has been in existence (it had no beginning, if we can fathom it), to the eternal future (it is too high for us to understand). Our Father has been looking for a home for billions of years, maybe trillions of years (we don't know how long it's been since the angels fell, or since He made Adam and Eve).

Our Father has been homeless for billions and trillions of years. He's been looking for a home where He can have fellowship. When He created Adam He must have said, "This is it!" Then He rested. He made a man; it was the greatest thing He had ever done. But it wasn't a home yet.

Our Master Yahshua was the slain Lamb from before creation. He knows who are willing to do His will. (Maybe we didn't today, but we're willing and we can repent.)

Eph 2:21-22 tells the whole story. For billions (trillions) of years He has been looking for a home, and now, finally, He is going to get redeemed man (through Yahshua) — not *restored* man. We're not restored Adam; that's not enough. We must go beyond that place. We ate from the tree of life; Adam did not. But even though he fell, our Father chose redeemed man, and he goes beyond restored man. There is no distinction between him and our Master except that He is our husband and we are His wife.

Our Master wants His home to come to earth. He is looking for sons, many sons. Our Father is building a house. (And while a house is being built you can't live in it. You have to pitch a tent until it's finished. Then you can live in it.) He is building a dwelling place (a home) so He can live in us for eternity, forever and ever. He is building something (Eph 2:21-22) in the Spirit and He is getting what He has been after for so long. Somehow it was revelation to Paul at the time that no one else knew. Eph 3:21 – This is speaking of *restored* man who will procreate offspring (multitudes of offspring). He wants to fill the universe with redeemed man. Rev 21:3

– His home will be with men (meaning two genders – man and woman), male and female propagating forever.

In 1 Tim 2:8, the word *man* means male, but in Rev 21:3 it means male and female, and they will be having babies forever. We won't be having natural babies because we'll be married to our Master Yahshua, but maybe we'll have spiritual offspring. Many people will be saved and we'll be ruling over the clans. He will be our husband and we'll be His wife. Maybe we'll have spiritual offspring (true spiritual cloning). We can ask the question, "How will there be so many people that we'll rule the galaxies?" He won't save enough people to rule the galaxies. But there will be billions in the next age. In the next 50 years the population is going to explode. (It will double in the next 40 years.) In the next age people will work and not die. In the eternal age people will be having babies forever and ever. So there'll be some type of reproduction.

He will be our husband and we'll be His wife (Rev 21:9). Our Father will reveal it to us by His Spirit. "*Eye has not seen nor ears heard what God has prepared for those who love Him*" (1 Cor 2:9). Right now, we can hardly take it in.

When we go places and we see a sunset and look up at the moon and the stars we say, "Isn't that *beautiful!*" "Look at that – isn't it *wonderful!*" But so many other people don't see what we see. They don't even notice the sunset or the stars. There's nothing in them anymore to appreciate creation. Our Father knew that He couldn't use them to propagate life forever. He's looking for a home – a place to dwell with men and women in the next age. "*I will be their God and they will be My people ...*" (Jer 31:33). This promise is already ours. Now, there are people dying all the time, starvation, people killing children, people overdosing on drugs and so much hurt and anguish. But He will wipe away the tears from the righteous and there'll be no more death. It is written in Rev 21:4 – "*No more death for you ...*" (This is not talking about the saints.)

In the next age we will rule with Him and we'll be *marvelous* rulers because we'll have the mind of our Master Yahshua. We are God's dwelling place. Our Master was a spiritual man who knew what to say and how to say it. And we are becoming like our Master. We're His

home. Christians say, “God doesn’t need man.” *Yes, He does!* That’s why He created us. He loves us. He has an ultimate purpose for this planet. And He has been waiting for trillions of years to have a home.

We need to understand this so we can see people in the world (natural people) and love them. They’re being led astray by the evil one and we need to tell them that they’re going over the waterfall soon.
