Make Sure No One is Left Out

Let's make sure that no one is left out. One of the worst thoughts I can have is to be left out of the kingdom. All my brothers and sisters going in and me out in the cold because I wasn't diligent to care for things in my life.

The commandment was written for ALL of us: See to it that no one misses the grace of YHWH. Not just a few. Just as sure as we don't do this, there will be a root of bitterness which will grow up and defile the many. This happened in the first community. Many people's garments were stained. This command is to those who are receiving grace. If we don't receive grace, soon there will be a root of bitterness that will defile you. The burden (responsibility) is on each one of you . You are so important, *derushah* — essential, necessary.

Our Father will show us how necessary each of us was, and, I hope that no one has to be shown how unfaithful he was. We must be immersed in that river of grace that ha-emeq talked about that comes from the throne. How many are going to forget to "see to it" that no one is missing grace today?

Heb 10:24 — Consider (think about it) how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds.

You have to sit down and consider what Neshef needs. What does Yochanan need? What does Lev Amatz need? Even in a little way. Go up and put your arm around someone or speak a kind word. We are members of one another. Let's stimulate one another to love and good deeds. Heb

3:13 — Encourage one another every week when you go to church. Is that what it says? Every

day. Encourage each other daily. We have to gather to do that.

ha-emeq — 2 Tim 2:7 It says consider what I said. Many times we hear something and we say "Oh I don't understand that." Or, we could think about these things while we are working. We'll be shallow people if we don't really consider. We have to grasp their application. Before we can encourage each other, we have to really consider ourselves.

Remember — constantly keep in mind — think over these things. Then we will be given full insight. We're not going to enter the kingdom without full insight. Prov 2 teaches us to have this understanding; you are to lift up your voice for it.

Heb 3:8 — Remember Messiah — risen from the dead (keep constantly in your mind). Lk 1:31-33; Eph 1:21 — YAHSHUA is seated on the throne in heaven ruling over the house of Jacob.

We are this house of Jacob — or at least the beginning of it.

2 Tim 2:8 — remember YAHSHUA... Did the first Edah remember YAHSHUA? They were the light of the world but it went out. It needs to be re-lit.

Dan 2:44 — Prophecy that this will happen. That is what you are — cut out of this world, being made into that kingdom. The restoration of that kingdom. Keep reading in Daniel and you will see what hard times we will have because the world system will come against us.

The first church had those words (2 Tim 2:7) too but maybe they were dull.

If we don't raise our children to receive the Holy Spirit then no one can come in and receive the Spirit. Mal 4:6 — If we don't, He'll come and smite the land with a curse. Yoneq said, "I would too because what use would it be anyway." Israel never turned their hearts towards their children.

Do you see the responsibility on yourself? The first church didn't see it. Are you seeing it now?

A few can't carry the majority. We have a great purpose. The first church is our example. What kind of example were they? There is the good example in Acts 2-4, but then there are the bad examples in the letters when they were falling away. Restoration has to take us back to Acts 26:7. Then we have to go to the end without waning. If each person isn't seeing to it, it will never happen.
