

The New Relationship

In the last supper that our Master had with His disciples He was trying to make them understand that He wanted to establish a new relationship with man — the new covenant, so that we can love Him with all of our heart.

God is one, so His people have to be one. We have to represent Him with all of our hearts. People who are one don't fight.

Philip asked our Master, “Sovereign, show us the Father” (Jn 14:8).

“*I am the true way.*” If we want to come to the Father we have to come through Yahshua.

“*The Father lives in Me and acts through Me.*” This is what He wants to get man to do. This is this new covenant. It takes suffering.

The victory cup is the cup of suffering. Through this we will become more and more like Him. If we never drink the cup we won't drink it with Him in the next age. If we drink it in pretense now we won't drink it either in the next age. There is a judgment.

A cup was handed to Him and He gave thanks. “*Take this and share it among yourselves. Take this in order to overcome. This cup stands for the new relationship between God and man.*”

Heb 5:7-9 — He went through great agony in order to take the cup. We have to do the same. He went to the throne of grace to qualify, to become our savior. If we want to be worthy of Him we need to go to the throne of grace.

Sometimes we don't drink the victory cup. We don't represent our Master to our brothers and sisters. Our love failed. That's why we are here. Ps 116:12-19 — What shall we do? I will lift up the cup of salvation in His presence. It is a re-consummation to lift up the cup. Our marriage is consummated and it is re-consummated all our lives. This shouldn't get old. One time we will get married to Him. This is a re-consummation of our relationship with Him (Lk 12:8-9).

Ps 116:16 — Everyone experiences these bonds. Sometimes our bonds aren't loosened. But He will loosen our bonds. The more we confess His name the easier it is going to get. The evil one is trying to hinder us to confess His name.

Ps 95:6 — We have to find out how to do it, how to worship and bow down and kneel before our Maker. I want to do it and kneel before Him. And this doesn't have to be a ritual either. Only those who have not received His Spirit will do rituals (Ps 116:12).

It is necessary to call out and confess His name to re-consummate our relationship with Him. There are many ways we break our relationship with Him. But even if we break it we can come here and confess His name. So let's do this and confess His name and put intimidation out the window. It's nothing but intimidation, it's nothing but an evil spirit that wants to hinder us to confess His name.

Ps 116 — Remember if you would be out in the ocean, drowning, going under for the third time and then there is a boat coming by, lights on it, warmth, a celebration going on on it, would you even think twice to call out with all your might? Would you be intimidated? Did we call upon Him when we got baptized? Yes. We will do that as long as we live.
