

## **One Government in Each Location**

*We had returned the previous night from England where we handed out “Wish You Were Here” papers at Pink Floyd concerts. On this tour we also met all types of Christians. Yoneq was sharing about Titus 1:5.*

Titus 1:5 — The elders were appointed apostolically with the approval of the respective edah in every city or location — one government, one eldership in each location. Even if they were spread out over the location, like for example, here in Bordeaux [*which is a big city and might have households in different parts of the city*], there is one government. In Acts 20:17 Paul sent for the elders from the edah in Ephesus. Paul was in Miletus about 20 miles away. The elders worked under his direction and there was one edah in Ephesus, one government. There can only be one government of God in one location, otherwise there is division. That is why 1 Tim 2:8 is a reality where His government in one location exists — all the men in the edah in that locality lifting up holy hands without wrath or dissension.
