Our Savior's Name

If our Savior's name is *Yeshua*, meaning, "He is salvation," or "He shall save," then you may wonder who *He* is. But if His name is *Yahshua*, the name itself is self-disclosing (Ps 68:4; Isa 56:6).

Sing to God, sing praises to His name... extol Him who rides on the clouds... by His name Yah, and rejoice before Him.

Isa 12:2 — Behold God is my salvation. I will trust and not be afraid. For Yah the Lord is my strength and my song. He has become my salvation.

Hallelu *YAH* — A command to praise Yahweh in *Yahshua*. *YAH* (3050 Strong's).

Num 13:16 — *Joshua* in the Hebrew language is *Yah Shua*, which means "Yahweh (the Lord) is salvation." So Mt 1:21 — the name *Yahshua*: "You shall call Him *Yahshua*, for He will save His people from their sins." You shall call his name *Yahshua*, which means "Yahweh will save," or "Yahweh's salvation." You shall call His name *Yahshua*, for He will save His people from their sins.

So *Yeshua*, "He shall save," is not a self-disclosing name, but *Joshua* is self-disclosing, for it is Yahweh Himself, in *Yahshua*, who shall save His people from their sins, as 1 Tim 2:5-6, Yahweh's salvation. It is Yahweh who shall save. *Yahshua* means "Yahweh shall save," not "He shall save."

1 Tim 2:6 — Who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time in the Gospel, the good news of Yahweh's salvation. *Yahshua* the Messiah, who is God our Savior (1 Tim 2:3; Ps 68). Isa 12:2 tells who this God is and what He did — who Salvation is, and His self-disclosing name *Yahshua*, not *Yeshua* (Jn 14:21).

Disclosing means allowed to be seen, and make known as a disclosure, broadcast, impart understanding which has been hidden by the name *Iesu*, or *Jesu*, *Jesus*, or *Yeshua*, for who knows who *He* is? "*He* is Salvation." Who is? But *Yahshua* tells who salvation is of (Jn 5:43; 17:11-12).

Self-disclosure is a revelation of the truth by a person's name, as *Elijah* (Acts 13:47).

Elohim = God is Yah, Yah is Elohim, or God. *Eli-Yah* made it clear who God was in 1 Kings 18:21,31, as *Israel* shall be your name. Verses 36-39 — Yahweh is Elohim, Yahweh, He is God, *Elijah*. Verse 40 — Then *Elijah* said to them (Isa 43:12) that Yah is Elohim — *Elijah*. "That I Am" — Yah is God — "I Am" God. For *He* shall save. Who is *He*? He is *Yahshua*, Yahweh's Salvation. He shall be known to the world (Isa 49:6; Jn 17:23,26; 3,6).

Your name is who you are, or who you are not (false identity). You are known by your name.
