Progressive Revelation

Hakam — I was just thinking about how totally inadequate we are — every day there are so many things that trip us up, cause us to stumble, get hopeless. I realized today how much our Father is with us, how much He carries us. He literally carries us in His Spirit. Our whole life is like that, we cry out to our Father to carry us. I know our God is going to have His way in our lives. In His faith we can go to Him. He's with us, He's going to bless us if we don't let the enemy of our soul wrap us up in things like introspection. Then we'll give our God the opportunity to help us in everything. Our encouragement cannot come from how well we can do things. Sooner or later that runs out and gets thrown by the wayside. But our God, He never gets thrown by the wayside, He never fails. Never. It's because of that, that we can wait on Him. Yoneq said the other day that we were waiting for revelation. I see that our God is holding us up until we receive revelation. Like when you teach someone to swim, you hold them up in the water by their belly until they have confidence enough that you're holding them and then they can put their head in the water. Our God is holding us up until we can actually swim. We have to learn to see that, otherwise we will be striving and have anxiety about everything. Our revelation doesn't come in a certain matter of years, but it comes according to how we progress inwardly, until we can see that revelation. He cannot give us revelation unless *we* progress, unless we are progressing by His Holy Spirit which He has put in our heart, and by our discipline. Then we have more enlightenment. He gives us revelation just to where we are at in obedience to Him. Jn 14:21 says very clearly that, "*He who has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and reveal myself to him.*" It's how we obey Him as we walk along in obedience. And as we obey, the more and more pure we are. And the more pure we are, the more revelation we will have — He will trust us with revelation.

He cannot trust His revelation in the hands of lawless men who will do crazy things. He cannot put His power in the hands of lawless men. He reveals these things as we are able to take them, as we are responsible. We cannot progress any further than where we are. He cannot reveal Himself any more than where we are — as far as where our will is. If we do not obey, we will be waiting for revelation until we die. And then the kingdom would be left to another people. But Daniel said that this kingdom will not be left to another people, but it will do its job — it will have full revelation.

ha-emeq: In Dan 2:44, "*left to another people,*" reminded me that we are the people that it was left to already one other time. Because the other day you said that in the first community, the spiritual people started to be despised by the other people who fell more and more away and it got to be where they were looked down on, because everyone else was so carnal. And because of that it was left to another people — they lost the kingdom. It made me want to be people who say, "NO, NO! I want to be the people!" And it's the time now, if we don't fall like them. But it was a super strong thing that caused them to fall. And they had people there who had even been with YAHSHUA, it was even a really recent happening that YAHSHUA had been with them. But then the carnal people took over and because of that, it was left to another people. It made me want to be the people. Because it *can* be left to another people.

Rev 3:4 — The flesh always persecutes the spirit. That is persecution. Satan himself persecutes the spiritual one through the fleshly one. And they say *spiritual* as a derogatory statement. A person who says that is of the devil.

Hakam: You can see why it has to happen in the last days. Because everything under the sun is going on and has been done and it's down to us and there's nothing left. The ways that were produced from the fallen ways of the first church (Christianity) isn't good enough. Our Father had to get it to where the human race was desperate, desperate for the absolute reality of the word.
