

Purification with a Purpose

The more our soul is purified the more we can love. It is just impurities that keep us from loving. We know whether we have passed out of death into life.

1 Pet 1:4,8,22 — Our soul has to go through purification so that we can love one another. One day we are going to love one another fervently. The Holy Spirit has been poured out into our heart, but I guess He is going to be poured out more in the days to come. 1 Pet 1:22 is where we are going. He was talking about people who have been in the edah for years. Why does our soul need to be purified? (1 Pet 1:22-25).

1 Pet 2:3 — We have only tasted it. It is just like something that is really good and you taste it. We haven't had the full meal yet — only the foretaste. We only have a down payment. Job 14:7-9 — We are not drinking the water yet. We only have a scent. The sun has not come up yet. The day is going to come when the sun comes up. One day we will be clothed with the sun, when we go into the wilderness. The brightest day we are going to have is when we suffer most, when we deliver the Male Child to go out into the world. That is when the woman will be clothed with the brightness of the sun. She is learning to rejoice in her suffering. She is loyal and won't give in to the pressures of the antichrist. The world won't be able to understand this. We love our children so much. We sacrifice them for something greater (Gen 22:1).

We sacrifice ourselves every day for something greater. We cherish our fellowship with our Master more than we want to sin. We have to love Him more than we love our flesh.

They will kill many of us. Some people will take the place of others, dying in their place. They will be doing it with joy, because they know our Master is coming. They will come back with Him and be reunited with their body. It is going to be a joy to us to put our head into the guillotine one day and get it cut off. That will be the absolute proof of a person's worthiness to rule with our Master in the next age (Rev 20:4). That will definitely prove that we love our brothers. We will not even experience death. We will die physically, but we will never

experience spiritual death. We will be absent from the body and present with the Sovereign. Death holds no fear for us — only if there is sin, a bad conscience.

Our soul will not be able to be with our Master unless it is purified. That is what 1 Pet 1:22 is trying to tell us. We have to be purified so that we would choose immediately to obey. Our will has to be so purified. Our soul is our will, our intellect, our emotions. Our emotions are going to be so attached to our Master that we won't go through an emotional thing. If we are afraid it means we are still not purified. There is a fear of death left. 1 Jn 3:14 — We have passed out of death into life.

1 Cor 15:55; verse 51 — We shall not all die. Verse 52 talks about the Yobel. The last thing to be changed is our body, the redemption of our body (1 Ths 5:23).

1 Cor 15:51-58 — The power of sin is the law. We are not under the law now. We are under grace. Verse 58 — These are the qualities we must have, always abounding in the work of Yahshua. He is in us working. If He would be here on the earth He would do it all by Himself. He couldn't be all the twelve tribes. That is why our Father had to sacrifice Him to get more sons. It is better that He would go so that He could do greater things in and through us.

Mt 24:34 — That is the generation He is talking about. 1 Cor 15:51 — We will not all die, but we will be changed. That is a promise. Some of us will not even die a physical death. There is a generation that will not see death before all things are fulfilled.

1 Ths 4:16 — The last trumpet, the shofar will blow. What will we do? Say “Halleluyah!” We will all praise our Master. Who is the archangel? Michael. Those who had their head cut off will raise first. When He comes back He will bring them with Him and their bodies will be raised (verse 17).

2 Ths 1:4-5 — Worthy, fitting for the kingdom, suitable, comparable, compatible — unless we go through suffering we cannot be made fit. This is talking about the very end of the days.

2 Ths 1:4-10; Isa 53:10 — It is amazing to know that our life will be prolonged to carry out the will of God fully, until the very end.

If I do not do what I am doing right now (bringing comfort with these words), I will see death, because I am obstinate. 1 Ths 4:18 — This is written to us. We have to comfort one another. The Holy Spirit gives us comfort. We need to know that even if some of us will die, that we go right to the presence of our Father. That is comforting. The Holy Spirit comforts us in our obedience to Him. When we are obedient to Him, He comforts us, like He did to Joshua and Caleb.

Prophets comfort. Prophecy comforts.

1 Cor 14:3,1 — Pursue love. What does *pursue* mean? Chase, pursue, desire spiritual gifts — especially that you may prophesy, because prophecy is for encouragement, exhortation, consolation, comfort, and the building up of the Body — edification.

If I am one who does not desire that, I'll see death. My soul will not go to our Master when it leaves its body. If I do not desire that, I am not obedient (Acts 3:23; Jn 8:51). Is that hard? Are we under the law? We are under the law of Messiah. We are under Him, His grace.

Did you know that you are to desire spiritual gifts. Now you know it. Once you know you will be blessed if you do what you know. If not, you will be cursed. But we take it positively, because we are not under the law but under grace. If all prophesy, an unbeliever will come into our midst, fall down, and acknowledge that certainly God is in our midst.
