

Sabbath Dishes

Sabbath dishes and eating utensils (cooking pans, etc.) are *set apart* for Sabbaths. After eating, all utensils and the napkins used for the meal (not including the utensils washed before the Sabbath begins) will be taken to the *water barrel*, or bucket, etc., already prepared for soaking. They will be washed on First Day or by a crew after the *minchah boker* on the Sabbath, who will finish the Sabbath dishes and utensils and store them in a set-apart place.

[The same will happen with our Breaking of Bread paraphernalia, like pillows, napkins, the cup, and the dishes — all will be done also by another crew First Day morning before the teachings (or before 9 AM at the latest), even if the crews need to arise early before dawn on this day to do this *priestly task*.]

This would of course save the Celebration from interruption.

We can always afford what we want. Special Sabbath plates and chop sticks, and knives, forks, and spoons, and pots and pans, and cloth napkins, all have a special crew Sabbath Eve after the meal to take these things to the special prepared place — for storage in soapy soaking water.
