Seek for Wisdom With All Your Heart

When parents or relatives come, we bring them to the sacrifice or we're cut off. We need to bring visitors to the center of our life — except for emergencies. When they visit, they come on our terms.

Sameach — I'm thankful our Master is Sovereign over all things — the sea, air, tulips (how do they come up?). I hear the birds all through the neighborhood — why can't humans do what they were created to do?

This morning we heard that when bees swarm it's not an independent thing, but it's an organized action, and where the queen is — the bees go. I want to go where my Master is. He has put us in a wonderful place — how can we have complaint? We need to follow our Master like the bees follow the queen. What more can our Father expect from His people whom He has given His Son to?

Yoneq — The only thing that keeps us from giving thanks is sin. If we don't confess it we become callused, operating in the flesh (like the Corinthian Church did). Don't let sin slide by — make sure your conscience is kept pure and you are serving our Master. He has great things in store for us if we don't trust our reasoning (our natural mind). All things that happen work together for good (everything) if we trust with all our heart and don't lean on our own understanding (Prov 3:5-6). I want to be healed in every way — spiritually, socially, mentally and physically.

Yahnathan — We'll become like our Master if we receive what He puts out for us each day. By law we were guilty, but by His mercy we are innocent. Our Master suffered greatly for us. I'm thankful for Him. And we have an opportunity right now to give thanks to Him.

Yoneq — Prov 2:2 — We can store up wisdom, but we have to seek for it like people used to seek for gold and silver. How did they do it? They risked their lives and went down into dark holes in the ground and sometimes they caved in. Daveed Derush told me how people mined for silver in the Amazon — he said it was horrible and many people died. so when they found silver it was really precious to them.

A lot of us haven't come to the fear of the Sovereign yet. We have to come to this place so we can be in perfect peace with one another. We have to discover the knowledge of God — it's going to have to happen to all of us. If we hunt for wisdom with all our heart — we'll find it! He can be found by those who seek Him with all their heart.
