Everybody is supposed to be hearing something in their ear. Faith is hearing. If we are not hearing, we are not living by faith. When we come together our Father speaks to us through each other - through what has been whispered in our ears. We live on that just as much as we live on physical food. When we come together for the sacrifice it shows our condition. It is wonderful how faith comes to us through hearing and that we must hear our Father through each other. It is encouraging that we can retain the things we hear, digest them, and bring them back. We are receiving faith. If we don't receive faith, we are not being saved. The community is not just a nice place to live, it is a hard place to live. Like right now the saints in Brazil are going through a lot of hardship.

Let no one speak except the utterance of God. When we hear this utterance we say "amen", I believe it, I trust in it, it strengthens me. We grow up into the head as we speak to one another. Eph. 4:15 We speak to one another in many ways - psalms, hymns, spiritual songs. And we shout from the rooftop what has been whispered into our ear. Faith comes by hearing, and hearing from the word of God. Whatever we do without faith is sin. Let's retain what we heard and speak about it during the day and when we come to the sacrifice we must share it. Not everybody hears to the same degree. That is why we all must share - we must take the responsibility. Some hear more, so they have greater responsibility. The dead cannot praise. Let's not be silent. If we are silent we are going down to silence. We are not doing what is pleasing to Him. It is pleasing that we would share with one another. One of the greatest acts of love is that we would speak to our brothers, encouraging them through the word. When we come together we share what we have heard so that everybody can know what you live by. Just like our body lives on food - you chew it up and then it assimilates. If you don't chew good, the food hardly does your body any good. You grow old fast. You have to chew your food good. That's why we sing that song about the oil flowing to the edge of the robe.

Our God gives us grace to build with. If we don't build with it He is going to take it away. Let's take the responsibility.

I hope we spoke to our guests who left yesterday and didn't just wait for somebody else to speak to them. That would be the ecclesiastical system. I thought they came here to be disciples, to move in here. I know if they are sheep, they won't be happy out there *[speaking about two women who came back with us from the fair in Paris]*.

Ps. 15 and Ps. 24 go together.

Who is a reprobate? Someone who will not change. Someone who keeps on hearing and hearing but nothing happens. It is like silver or gold that won't be purified. A reprobate is someone who could care less about the sacrifice of YAHSHUA.
