Eph 5:8 — Singing Songs

Yoneq does not want us to always be under pressure to ALWAYS sing a song at the Minchahs. It can become a drudgery to sing the "same old song" every time. At the minchah when we gather we do not always even need to sing at all. We can sometimes share from our hearts, with life!

The MUSICIANS must be given time to learn new songs and bring them with revelation. They need time to devote to their gift, just like teacher's do, not be caught up in the sin of Luke 21:34 — the overseers and elders must give answer for this at the judgment (Heb 13:17).

It will bring death to both the musician and the people if they must sing out of *rote* (Plus it will ruin the nice song that you *oversing*).

Matt 6:33 — If there is life in the musician and he is *prepared* he can bring a new song often. But also the people must try to bring songs (and be prepared to sing it alone if not everyone knows it).

Yoneq said there are psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. Song, a *psalm*, is right from the Bible. A hymn is a deep song, and a *spiritual song* is singing in the Spirit (like Rick Kendrick style).
