Speaking in Faith

*Giving of Thanks*

Someday every knee shall bow and every tongue confess that Yahshua is King. We are all going through many things, oppression has come upon us, but we need to confess that He is Sovereign in our lives — we cry out and He hears us. Speak — don't be silent. Ps 115:17 — The dead do not praise YHWH. But we are alive and we praise Him, because He has heard our cry, our supplication for mercy. Ps 116:1-2; Verse 10 — I believed, and then I spoke. We are going to grow up into the Head in every aspect if we speak to one another.

*Believe*

*Believe* — to accept trustfully and on faith, to consider to be true or honest, steadfast.

We speak by faith. Shimony Yom thinks she doesn't have any faith, but she spoke this morning and she has wonderful faith in her. We need to speak the faith that our Father has given to us. For years I tried to get Derush to take walks around the block and to start by thanking and praising our Master and then pouring out his heart to Him. Walking around the block is a wonderful time to pray and tell our Father everything we have on our heart to Him. We have freedom of speech. He wants to hear from us. He gives us nothing else but the desire of our heart. He has all the money in the world — He is not a cheap God. We can ask according to His will and He will answer. We have to go to Him in faith about everything and believe and speak the faith we have on our heart.

Sometimes doubt comes to us like at the breaking of bread — Ps 116:12 — What shall I render to Him for all He has done for me? Verse 13 — I will call on His name, exactly what we did when we were baptized, and whoever does this will be saved. We pay our vows to Him and we will never be disappointed. Next week at the breaking of bread if doubts come to you, call on His name with a loud voice. Doubt makes you not speak, but belief in our Master causes you to speak. We believe, therefore we speak. 2 Cor 4:13 — When we put our trust in Him we will be established. 2 Chr 20:20 — This is to believe. Eccl 30:18 — Words spoken on a dumb (closed) mouth are like putting food on a grave. Just think — what if one of our women spent all day fixing food and then she took it and put it on a grave. It's just like speaking words all day and someone not hearing what you're saying.

Mal 3:16-17 — Those who fear Him will speak and He will hear and write our names in a book of remembrance. Dan 12:1 — He will rescue all those whose names are written in that book.

*Speaking in Faith*

If we believe, we'll speak. If we don't speak our name won't be written in the book of remembrance and we won't be rescued. If we can't speak we need to cry out and risk being made a fool of in front of our brothers who all love us. What good does it do to lavish our words on a person who won't speak? If we don't speak it means we're dead. Let's speak on these things. Let's be those who speak. If we can't speak we need to expose our withered condition and pretty soon we'll have faith. Walk around the block and tell our Master what's on our heart. Tell Him, "It's not right that I can't speak. I believe. I haven't committed a sin unto death. I'm your son, how can I go on? I want you to get rid of everything that keeps me from hearing you speak to me."

I told Derush to walk around the block and not do things without faith. I told him to tell our Master what was going on inside of him. Tell Him everything, don't go on without grace.

Shaul — I'm thankful that our Father speaks to us. Without Him we couldn't do anything.

Because of His word we can be saved. He convicts me, but He gives me hope. I want to learn to

speak. I'm thankful for what I heard today. The enemy has kept me dumb, making me think that my family is dumb because we are uneducated. This is not true. I want to overcome and speak.

Christopher — I walk along and the arrows of the enemy come everyday, but when I put on my armor each day I can cast off the enemy and go on and overcome.
