Talents

Talents — are to build up and not destroy. A normal disciple has a Bible (and brings it to the sacrifices), takes in the teachings and talks about the Word.

Yahnathan — Each person has a part in the Edah and we need to be diligent to do our part and grow up into all aspects of the Head. I'm starting to see who we are — each one of us has to be working properly.

Aspect — means whole personality. If we're led by the Spirit, we're children of God. Eph 4:12 — is for the equipping of the saints (our work of being a servant). The obstacles are being removed from us, or we are being removed. If you love the world, please go and be where your love is! 1 Jn 2:15 — to love the things of the world (cars, etc.) — if we love the world the love of the Father is not in us. We can't drink from two cups (country music and singing praises) — we can't eat from the table of evil spirits and the table of our Master at the same time. We'll work extra hard for bus fare and give it to you to leave if you love the world! Does anyone want to go back?

Then we're in good company — we are home.

Racham — We have no more fear of rejection. We used to be Gnostics — and we thought we were saved by what we knew. But now we know we have a relationship with Him if we obey Him — it's not enough to know, but we have to do something. All that's happened here in Boston is worth it for Keli, Haggai and Shaul's voices to be loosed!

I don't want to be a Gnostic — I want to do His will. I left all behind; I didn't come here to be a coward — there's no way we'll make it if we are. What was shared today washed me and set me on course.

Haggai — At the end of the "Dysfunction teaching it says, "if we go on in our own strength and don't cry out for grace — it's dysfunction." There's no hope for us if we do that — we won't change. But if we're connected to Him we'll have His words on our lips and we'll build Him up. It's normal that we'd have to cry out for grace to be connected to Him. When we lift our hands we are showing Him we're clean and we absolutely surrender with nothing to hide.

I was thankful for the story last night about the blind man who was healed. It was simple — like the gospel — all we know is that we're healed.

Shaul — I can have confidence I have eternal life because I love my brothers — it's a simple love affair of the heart. And we're all doing this together.

Salome — I'm so thankful I can stand before Him with nothing to hide and I can be blameless because I've told Him everything and He has washed me. It means so much to me.

Yoneq — Jn 7:38-39 — Our Master had rivers of life flowing out of Him, and we should have to! If you don't have it, you don't have life. You can detect if a person is receiving grace or not.

Don't let anyone exist here without rivers of life flowing out of them. Go to one another and

make sure no one misses grace — this is love. If not, we are an accessory to a crime — we are a murderer (we're not being our brother's keeper) and we have to have a river flowing again. If you've never saw that river in a person since their baptism, you'd wonder about them. We help one another keep in that river of life.
