After Russia and the Arab countries are destroyed, there will be 'peace', no more need for war, except the last and final war to end all wars. South Korea is Christianized pretty well by now. I don't know if they let you make true disciples there. We want to see a wide open door in Spain, Germany, and England. We want to see that they let us train our children in Germany. Otherwise we won't know. It is in conjunction with our prayers that those doors open up. He cannot give us any more than the desires of our heart. We cannot go beyond that. If there is no desire in our heart then He cannot give us anything.

When we sing we speak to one another. You can tell by this if you love our Master, if you are in fellowship with Him. When we sing we look at each other, you don't look out the window. The eyes are the window of your soul. It doesn't say anything about singing in the New Testament except to sing to one another. Don't even go through the motion of singing if you don't want to sing to one another.

Whatever is in our heart, to that degree we participate in His purpose now and for eternity. He only can give us our heart's desire.
