The Wise in Heart Wins Souls —

Instruction on CDs

[A sister found some CDs that some guest left in one of our tents. There were ugly faces on them, and the texts contained evil words. She was always going to ask someone else what she should do with them. But she ended up leaving them in the sewing room where others saw them, and children took them into their hands.]

There was a whole bunch of CDs in a bag here. They are ungodly CDs. They don't belong to anyone. Whoever they belong to needs to leave this place. I destroyed them, stamped on them outside. Don't allow ever anything like this to exist here. If you find something like this, destroy it or bring it to an elder. Do what I did, I destroyed them. All kinds of people were looking at them, children were looking at them, reading them.

Someone had found them in a tipi under a cover. They belonged to a guest who was here a while back. The person who found them should have taken care of this matter in a better way.

Pr 11:30 — This proverb doesn't teach us how to be wise, but it tells us what wise people do. If we are already wise we'll do that. You can't gain wisdom by doing this. We are already wise. The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life. That's the tree Adam was supposed to eat from, but he ate from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. If he had eaten from the tree of life, he would have been sealed with the Holy Spirit forever. His destiny would have been sealed. He would have been stamped. He ate from the tree of knowledge of good and evil after which his destiny depended on his own strength and goodness. He was deceived so many times and almost went into the second death. He still has to be judged. He had to work for his own salvation. If he had eaten from the tree of life, a work would have been done for him. We are sealed.

What does the one who is wise do? He wins souls. He gives them the fruit of the tree of life.

What does *win* mean? Like in a game — you win them over to Messiah. When someone comes to Messiah, he has won the victory. He is abiding in the vine; he is attached to Messiah.

1 Cor 6:17 — That forms the Body. They can't live outside of the Body anymore. Just like your arm can't. Your spirit is in every part of your body. Your blood flows to every part of the body. Every part is obedient, attentive to the head so we can have a functioning physical and spiritual body.

If you are not wise you won't do it. The wise will shine like the stars forever and ever.

*Win* — capture souls for God. Who won you over? There is probably one person that won you over, captured you, persuaded you. That person was wise. Such people are fishers of men. Are you a fisher of men? Did you ever fish for Him? When you go to a fair or exposition, did you ever fish for Him?

I don't know if it's by a pole or by a hand. You need a certain amount of wisdom and skill. You need to know the fish, get close to him, go underneath him. You need to have wisdom and understanding. I can't go down there in the river and catch a fish by my hand. I can't do it. You need wisdom.

Yitzhak can do it. Some people run people off, some people are wise. We need to be wise fishers of men. If I'm not wise, I run people off. I run the sheep off and catch the goats.

We'll have a goat-herd. We are a sheep-herd, not a goat-herd.

Wise — understanding, insight, astute, clever. I'd like to look *wise* up in a dictionary to know what it really means.

Our Master was wise — He knew what to say and how to say it. He knew whom to have mercy on and whom to run off. John the Baptist called people a brood of vipers.

We capture people for God. We are representatives of God. If you receive someone's representative, you receive the one whom he represents. Whoever receives such a childlike person receives Messiah.

Let's pray — "Father, make me wise, I am not wise." I want to go down there and catch these fish. I think if you catch them by hand you can get so close to them that you can pat them on the belly.

How many human lives have you captured so far by your wisdom that our Father gave you? I remember when a fish swam into the Old Schoolhouse. We didn't have to do anything. We just had to be wise and talk to him and send him over to Island Pond. He wasn't a fish, he was a sheep — Yehezqel.

Pr 11:30 — He gathers and receives them for eternity. Verse 31 — The next verse says the righteous will be rewarded, paid back. The wicked also. We'd rather be righteous than wicked. We are barely saved; can you imagine then what about the wicked?

Dan 12:1 — Michael is the great angelic prince who defends your people, Daniel. Who are Daniel's people? The people living at the end of the age who are capturing people's souls, who are wise. We are Daniel's people.

It will be the worst time in history, horrible, horrifying. You can't even imagine how bad it's going to be. "Your people" — no one else will be delivered. Everyone whose name is found in the book of life. It just says, "the book." Is your name in the book? How do you know your name is in the book? Why is it in the book?

Yakob Israel: If I'm sealed with the Holy Spirit.

Okay, there are some people's names in the book, some people's aren't. Verse 2 — age-lasting, not forever and ever; some will enter into the kingdom at the time we are resurrected, and some will enter into shame. You'll weep and gnash your teeth because of what you remember about yourself and everything you didn't take care of. You put it off and off and off till it was too late and you couldn't even repent anymore. You got a stained garment. It has to be put into some chemicals to get rid of the stain. You have to be turned over to the torturers and be tortured inwardly. We didn't pray for people, for our brothers and sisters, didn't pray to be delivered from the evil one. Those who didn't pray for that were turned over to the evil one. There are so many people who care less, who don't go to the throne of grace and who don't confess their sin. Such people will be turned over to the evil one. 1 Cor 5:5 — Even that man was turned over.

Mt 6:9-13 — If we don't want to be led into temptation, if we don't want to be turned over to the evil one, we have to pray. If we don't pray pretty soon we are in a state where we don't care. We are indifferent to whether people are saved, whether our brothers have grace, whether they are doing good deeds. We don't care. We have a stained garment. We pollute the sacrifice.

Dan 12:2 are people who belong to Messiah, but whether they enter the next age depends on whether they are wise, won souls, walked in the good works they were saved for.

Mt 12:32 — If someone commits the unpardonable sin by rejecting Messiah, not believing in God, that sin won't be able to be forgiven in this age or the next age. If there is no correction in the next age, the smoke of the torment will go up forever and ever in the eternal age. Such a person is not willing to do God's will, otherwise he will know whether the teaching is of God or of man.

Verse 3 — They'll shine like the firmament, like the stars. They'll be the exact representation of God Himself to the people in the universe. They teach people godliness, wisdom, understanding,

win their souls. Those who turn many to righteousness will shine like the stars forever and ever. That tells us something — if we are wise we'll turn many to righteousness. Otherwise we'll be put into a place of regret that we didn't become wise and win people's souls, a place of age-lasting shame.

Dan 11:33 — You are the foundation stones. Our Father chose you first. If this doesn't mean anything to you, you are probably not chosen. He chose to be rounded in the word to bring in the multitudes. If you are chosen you are extremely glad. You will be wise, turn many to righteousness. You are God's representatives.

Dan 12:10 — There are the wise, and there are the people who still retain their crooked bent in them and have not been made upright and purified. So when our Master returns, they have to go into a place of refinement. We need to be refined in this age. Those who don't want the refining in the Body are the wicked. Those who are wise shall understand. If you are not wise you won't understand. If you are willing you will understand. But I guarantee in the next age you'll understand when that full blast, that full heat is turned on.

Mk 9:43-50 says people will be thrown where the worm never dies and the fire doesn't go out. Everyone will be salted with fire, the purifying fire of affliction. Have salt in yourselves. That means — no underground. If someone speaks something wrong to you, you expose it. Let's be purified with that fire, have that salt in ourselves, maintain the peace and purity in the Body. Salt maintains our purity, preserves us, maintains peace in the Body. Be sure your sins will find you out.

If we don't ask for wisdom, if we don't say, "Deliver me from evil," then we deserve to be turned over to the torturers, to be cast out of the kingdom because we are obstinate people.
