Marriage

Rivers of Living Water

We expect this, it is not what we have to pray for. This is what He gives. All the ability we have must be executed by grace. Grace is the provision He's given us. We don't have to labor for it in prayer. He desires to give it so if we desire it we will have it.

Marriage, Continued

We must read *For This Cause* before any wedding. All weddings are called off without knowing this. Repetition is good. It emphasizes things and puts them into our heart. When a wife kisses her husband she totally submits to him, 100%. Both the man and wife have to die to 100% love and 100% submit.

What are we going to do about Deuteronomy 24:5? How are we going to apply it in the New Covenant? This is the time when bonding takes place. We have to talk about this and also things like when a woman is on her period. She should not do her normal type of hard work. It's not good then to strain and work hard. In the Old Covenant they were put aside to rest for a week. The woman with the issue of blood was ostracized for 18 years. Our Master saw that. He healed her.
