### Worship in Spirit and Truth

Some songs we sing to our Master, some we sing to each other. Never sing looking out the window or looking at the floor. Don't sing if you're not singing with all your heart. This is taking His name in vain. It is a tremendous sin to sing in rote. It is the same as not loving Him with all your strength, soul and heart. If we're not loving Him this way we are actually hating Him, like if you're not loving your wife or your children you're hating them. 1 Cor 16:22. If you are not showing affection then you are accursed. We can be cut off in the middle of the assembly and not even know it. The worst people are those who claim to see but really don't. Rev 3:4. Most of these members were cut off from the vine, they had stained their garments. Very few of them were worshipping in spirit and truth. If He has found us we will worship Him in spirit and truth or He will have to find another people.

When you sing don't let it out of your mouth if it is not with all your heart, soul and mind, thinking of Him. Meditate on the words of the song. When we think about other things we have drifted. Drifting is a state of separation.

The sacrifice will not go up without incense. The priests trim the lamps and get the incense burning. We are ready to present ourselves now and He will receive it.

In His faith, not our faith. Whenever you have a hard time remember Eph 3:12. We have freedom of speech. We can go to the Father in His faith (Greek) and this gives us faith. The Father hears us through Yahshua no matter what spills out through us. Our Master makes sure the Father knows our heart. He is the mediator, and our lawyer. We have the freedom to say anything we want to say. Tell Him what is going on in your life and grace will come to you. He will straighten it out in you. Let Him straighten it out by blurting out everything to Him.
