

“You Worm, Jacob”

Our Master laid down His life unto death for us, and we have nothing else to do than to do the same. (Hakam and Havah lay down their lives unto death, serving the Body wherever they are. They go here and there and serve as our Master did.)

The Male Child will be sent out and give up their lives unto death, and they'll overcome the evil one because they're not loving their own lives. We can do no less than our Master did. That's our calling. We must hate our life in the world in order to be His people. There's no other way to have eternal life. And if not, then we don't have eternal life. Our lives belong to our Master. He is our Master. He owns us, “lock, stock, and barrel.” I'm thankful I can be part of His people, those who serve Him, no longer living for themselves.

ha-emeq: In Rev 12:10-11 it says a voice will “SHOUT” from heaven saying, “All authority has been given to our God and the accuser who had accused the brethren day and night has been cast down. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not cling to their lives even unto death.” A voice will “SHOUT” from heaven saying, “THEY OVERCAME! The *accuser* has been cast down!”

Finally, after billions of years. The first thing it says they did was overcome by the blood of the Lamb and then by the word of their testimony. Are we overcoming by the word of our testimony and by the blood of the Lamb (keeping ourselves pure, confessing our sins and admitting our weaknesses) and not clinging to our lives even unto death? It says, “By the word of their testimony.” What's your testimony? It's the way we live our life for our Master Yahshua.

Havah: Our work is to believe. The reality of what we're doing is overcoming evil. The natural way to overcome is by strength, but we overcome by doing the opposite thing — laying down our life. It takes faith to do this. It takes believing and following the path that our Master Yahshua has for us. It takes work to do this. It's a labor.

I'm thankful I've been given faith to do this and I can lay down my life every day. There are people in the world who lay down their lives for some cause, but it doesn't bring about a change. I'm thankful we can lay down our lives and it has a desired effect.

Our Father has a people that the evil one can't rightly accuse anymore because now we are living for our Master Yahshua. And we live for Him how many hours a day? Twelve hours, or more? Twenty-four hours a day! We don't live for ourselves anymore. And we are *continually* talking about our Master (day and night). He is our Master and we have nothing else to talk about. He is our life.

Keli: What we are talking about reminds me of something we've said about how everything we do matters — what we say and how we say it, and what we do and how we do it. Our test is our life together. What we do during the day matters.

Hakam: This is what sets us apart from the world — how we do the things we do and say the things we say. That's what will bring about the witness that the evil one can't accuse anymore. He won't be able to say, “It's a false witness.” That's a lie! The work of the evil one has always been to accuse, but this time there'll be a people he can't accuse. But if we don't pay attention now to what's being said and do what we hear, we can't be that “testimony” it speaks about in Mt 24:14. There has to be that *testimony*, a demonstration before the end will come; the Gospel will go forth as a *testimony* of the kingdom of God.

That testimony has to be a demonstration of the life. As we go about our day and speak about these things our Father will give us more confidence to proclaim to the world who He is and it'll make the evil one tremble. When our Father has a people who will stand up and speak before the world then the evil one won't be able to use his weapons against them any more.

Our Master is going to return for a people who are putting their enemies under His feet.

Then on that day He will act as it says in Mal 4:3. It's going to be as in Isa 43:10-13:

“You are My witnesses,” says the Sovereign, “And My servant [that's us!] whom I have chosen, that you may know and believe Me, and understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God formed, nor shall there be after Me. I, even I, am the Sovereign, and besides Me there is no savior. I have declared and saved, I have proclaimed, and there was no foreign god among you. Therefore you are My witnesses,” says the Sovereign, “that I am God. Indeed before the day was, I am He; and there is no one who can deliver out of My hand; I work and who will reverse it?”

He is going to act on that day when He comes.

Isa 41:8 – “But you, Israel, are My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen.” (He isn't talking about any other people here, but us.) Verses 9-10 say,

“I have chosen (called) you and have not cast you away. Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you. I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.”

Then in verse 12 it says,

“You shall seek them and not find them – those who contended with you. Those who war against you shall be as nothing.”

Finally, in verse 14 it says,

“ ‘Fear not, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel! I will help you,’ says the Sovereign and your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.”

He’s not belittling Israel here, but we *are* like a helpless worm. He is going to help us. He says He will strengthen us. We are so puny, aren’t we? Things distress us so quickly, but our Father is with us and He will keep us. We’re a “worm” aren’t we? It’s *good* to be a worm! Then we have to trust in Him to protect us. We don’t have a mighty army. And on that day when our Father attacks *He* will do a mighty and great thing. He will do what He has already promised He’ll do.

Huldah: What comes to me as I was hearing what’s being said is that our Father is pleased with His worm. It makes me think about Isa 49:5-6, where it’s talking about how it’s too small a thing that we would be that light to the nations. He is pleased with us, that we’re going to glorify Him on the earth — us, a little worm of a person who can’t even get up in the morning without Him helping us.

I’m thankful for what He has for me to do today so I can help further that purpose. I want to do what’s pleasing to Him. I want to go to Him and ask for the grace to please Him.

We’re not even a “worm” yet. But He wants us to believe and trust Him. He says, “*Fear not.*” If we do, we’re disobedient. We don’t have to fear.

Hakam: It’s so wonderful that we are the only people on the face of the earth that have the privilege to trust Him, to let Him have “trust” over us. Our Master is the Head over the Edah. His Spirit is over us and we have the privilege to trust Him. Our Master trusted His Father that He didn’t make a mistake with His life; He trusted Him. He went before us and walked this out in His life.

His banner over us is love. All the world will know that we are His disciples if we love one another. There’s nothing greater than to talk about our

Master. He is our King and there’s nothing greater that we can do than to talk about our King.
