The Zeal Our Master Wants in His People

Jn 2:13-22 — Our Master didn't want a man-made temple, but a temple of people — His body. Vs. 17 — Zeal for His house should consume us. Vs. 16 — Sometimes we need to be whipped out of the temple — we offer up bad sacrifices (some people didn't care what they offered — pigeons, lame animals). The only way we can show that His zeal consumes us is by showing love for Him — what we do in the body is for the building up of His Body. We walk in the good deeds He has prepared for us (and in doing so will extend our life). Every morning we need to come here to do what we were created to do — if we aren't we're worthless vessels! We need to pray that we'd have life (chayah) and not just life, but abundant life (a life-giving spirit flowing out of us). We have stored-up grace, not just for ourselves, but overflowing for others. If we get up at the wakeup call, we have sufficient time to get our family ready. If we sleep in, we aren't zealous for His kingdom — we shouldn't even bother coming!

Rev 7:12-17 — Who are the ones who have come out of the great tribulation? They're the male child (the 144,000) and if people do good to them they'll inherit the Kingdom prepared for them (Matt 25:34) — they will be blessed or cursed by how they treated Abraham's seed.

Rev 7:16; Rev 16:9 — We will be in the wilderness being comforted, but everyone else will be out in the hot sun — the 144,000 will not be protected either, but will be burned by the heat. They will suffer more than anyone has ever suffered (except for our Master), and they'll be put in prison with no food and they'll die. In Rev 6:10 — They are still speaking with a loud voice before the armies of Heaven come and pour out wrath upon the earth. Mt 25:35-40 — In this time those who fed the hungry, visited them in prison, clothed them and gave them something to drink (the 144,000) — whoever befriends them will be worthy to be kings in the nations someday. They will be saved into the nations — they were that way already because they lived by their conscience all their lives. They will be blessed and have eternal life in the nations — they are the ones who didn't take the mark of the beast. The mark of the beast will probably be experimented with in areas where there are tribes, and we'll live on dried vegetables and fruits

and water from our wells — and we'll be cut off from everything (food, electricity, etc.) and then we'll send out the 144,000 and we'll go into the wilderness. And at the right time our Master will come back for those who are dressed and ready (this is the significance of the sacrifice when the shofar blows). Those who aren't taken will be left behind. He will come back for the called, chosen and faithful — Rev 7:14. He gives us plenty of time to prepare for His coming, so we'll have no excuse if we have not stored up oil! Our Father gives us vision for the future — where we're going.

Yonah — I have so much apathy — I was raised in it all my life. I want to have abundant grace so I can give it out and still have plenty stored up. I'm thankful for our Father speaking to us. I want to put vision of the male child into my children — this is why they were created. I want to be for our Master.

Rev 14:10-11 — Once someone takes the mark of the beast they are sealed with Satan's spirit — there is no way to get out of it. People are experimenting putting electrodes in cars now (also in prisoners) so they can keep track of you and know wherever you go. It's already being done — the day is coming upon us.
